Fiction

- Bradley, Alan *Sweetness at the Bottom of the Pie* – A precocious, motherless 11 year old girl with a passion for poisons investigates when a body is found in her garden.
- Cain, Chelsea *One Kick* – A woman, abducted from her Seattle home at age six and found five years later, tries to find and rescue a missing child while facing her past.
- Carey, M. R. *The Girl with All the Gifts* – Every morning a young girl waits in her cell and is strapped into her wheelchair at gunpoint to go to class. Find out why.
- Chevalier, Tracy *The Last Runaway* – A Quaker woman is forced to rely on strangers in the harsh landscape of 1850 Ohio and becomes involved in the Underground Railroad.
- Doerr, Anthony *All the Light We Cannot See* – A blind French girl and a German boy, whose paths collide in occupied France, try to survive the devastation of World War II.
- Erdrich, Louise *The Round House* – A teenager sets out to find the person responsible after his mother, a tribal enrollment specialist for the Ojibwe in North Dakota, is attacked.
- Hendrix, Grady *Horrorstör* – After strange things start happening at the Orsk furniture superstore three employees work overnight to investigate and discover something horrifying.
- Hood, Ann *The Obituary Writer* – An obituary writer searching for her missing lover at the turn of the 20th century is linked to a woman considering leaving her marriage in 1963.
- Ishiguro, Kazuo *Never Let Me Go* – Three friends who are human clones created solely to serve as organ donors experience love, loss, and betrayal as they ponder their destinies.
- Joyce, Rachel *Unlikely Pilgrimage of Harold Fry* – An Englishman decides to walk 500 miles to deliver a letter to a dying former coworker and meets various characters along the way.
- Kent, Hannah *Burial Rites* - In rural Iceland in 1829, a young woman awaiting execution is housed at a local farm and tells her history to a local priest. Based on a true story.
- King, Stephen *11/22/63* – An ordinary schoolteacher travels back in time in order to prevent the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

- Larsson, Asa ***The Second Deadly Sin*** – After the discovery of a brutally murdered woman in a northern Swedish village a prosecutor delves into the victim's tragic family history. **(Rebecka Martinsson mysteries #5)**
- Hoffman, Alice ***The Museum of Extraordinary Things*** – A girl grows up in her father's Coney Island museum of curiosities and pursues an love affair with a Russian immigrant.
- McCall Smith, Alexander ***Tears of the Giraffe***– Botswana investigator Precious Ramotswa searches for a young man who vanished many years ago on the African plains while dealing with the changes in her life. **(No. 1 Ladies' Detective Agency Series #2)**
- Macallister, Greer ***The Magician's Lie*** – A famous female illusionist stands accused of her husband's murder and has only one night to convince a small-town policeman of her innocence. **(Publication Date: January 13th, 2015)**
- Nesbo, Jo ***The Son***- A man, serving time for crimes he did not commit in exchange for heroin, learns disturbing truths about his police officer father's suicide.
- Oates, Joyce Carol ***The Gravedigger's Daughter***– A young woman whose parents fled Nazi Germany begins a life-changing pilgrimage throughout America in the wake of a tragedy.
- Picoult, Jodi ***Leaving Time*** - A woman whose mother, an elephant researcher, disappeared when she was 3 years old searches for her with the help of a psychic and an ex-cop.
- Simsion, Graeme ***The Rosie Project***– A professor sets up a project designed to find him the perfect wife and then he meets Rosie who is everything he's not looking for in a woman.
- Watson, S.J. ***Before I Go to Sleep*** –A woman awakens each morning with no memory of the last 20 years. As she tries to regain her past disturbing questions arise.
- Weiner, Jennifer ***All Fall Down*** – Struggling with the demands of her job and her difficult family a woman becomes addicted to painkillers and lands in rehab.

- Sarno, John ***Healing Back Pain*** – A physician discusses how some types of back pain may be due to stress and other psychological factors and what steps one should take to combat it.
- Nichols, Wallace ***The Blue Mind***- The surprising science that shows how being near, in, on, or under water can make you happier, healthier, more connected, and better at what you do.
- Tulku, Tarthang ***Tibetan Meditation***- This book provides practical teachings and step-by-step exercises on how to live in harmony, peace, and happiness using meditation.
